**CONSTRUCTION SITE MANAGEMENT**

Is there a construction site next door to you? Is it kept litter free? The city has a construction code which contractors are required to follow; a sign must be posted. Hours are 7 am to 6 pm; litter and waste must be contained. Rights-of-way (city sidewalks for example) may not be used for staging unless a barricade permit is approved by the Department of Public Works and Transportation.
